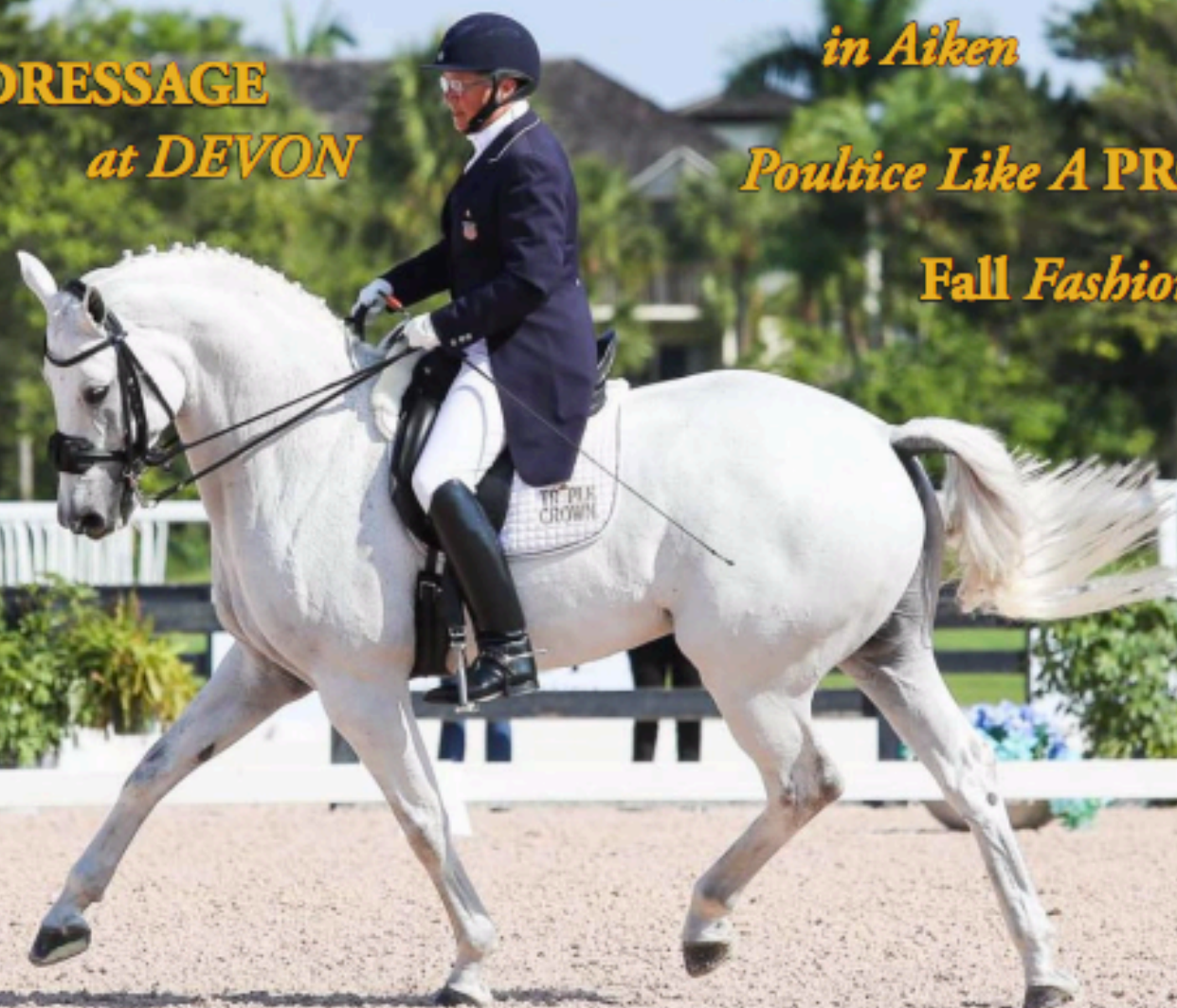

# Riding the Carolinas

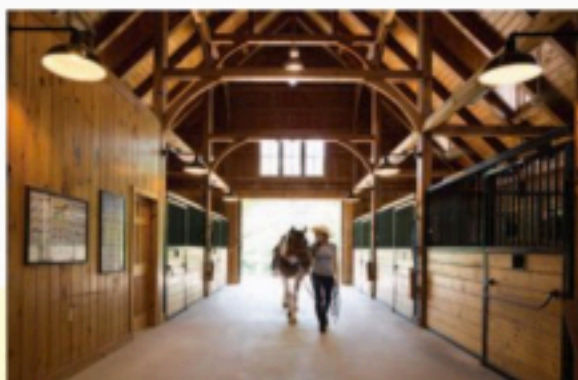
